All of the documents have to be available, and they have to be accurate. "Here, the details are critical, and if international business documents aren't done right, you run into many, many problems, for example, shipments being returned at the border, or horrendous fines imposed by the government," says Heiko.

Worldwide document support for conducting international business requires dozens of forms, including purchase orders, picking lists, packing lists, invoices, CMRs and customs documents.

"The Canadian French are different than the French French, who are different than the Belgian French. Even Germany, Italy, France and Spain all have different, but important ways of doing business."
